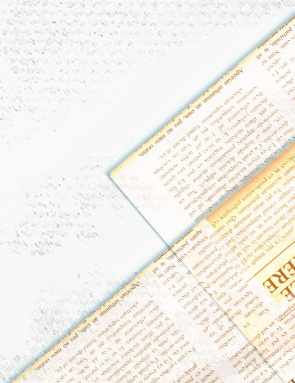
Program Highlights

- **Format:**

- The entire course will be conducted in English. Arabic-English interpretation will be available.
- Four online seminars (2 hours each) led by top practitioners and experts in:
 1. Media Ethics and Responsibility.
 2. Data-Driven Journalism and Digital Transformation.
 3. Debunking Disinformation.
 4. Covering Criminal Activities.
- A 4-day advanced in-person seminar in Rome at the LUISS School of Government, reserved for 10 participants selected from all course attendees based on their commitment and performance during the online sessions, offering:
 - Practical exercises and role-playing.
 - Networking with seasoned journalists and conflict resolution experts.
 - Institutional visits to major media outlets.

Eligibility:

- Candidates must be Libyan citizens.
- Candidates must be at least 25 years old.
- Candidates must have demonstrated experience in journalism or media-related fields.
- Active engagement in journalism or media.
- Interest in addressing societal and media issues.
- Commitment to participating actively.



Selection Procedure

Once the applications have been submitted, a selection committee comprising representatives from the LUISS School of Government, the Italian Embassy in Tripoli, and the Government Communications Center will review and evaluate the candidates to ensure a fair and thorough selection process.

- Ethical journalism in conflict settings.
- Strategies to combat disinformation and hate speech.
- Data collection and analysis techniques.
- Multimedia storytelling and investigative journalism in conflict zones.
