



10 Full Scholarships for MENA Students - Master in Mediterranean Cooperation and Security

Applications must be forwarded using **this form** by **20 June 2025.**

Following the support of *Med-or Foundation*, Luiss School of Government will award a scholarship, consisting of a full tuition waiver, to **10 candidates** who are nationals and resident at the time of the application in the **Middle East and North Africa (MENA) region** to take part in the next edition of the <u>Master in Mediterranean Cooperation and Security</u>.

• The scholarship covers full tuition fees.

Applications are accepted from the following countries:

Algeria, Bahrain, Egypt, Iraq, Israel, Jordan, Kuwait, Lebanon, Libya, Morocco, Oman, Palestinian Territories, Oatar, Saudi Arabia, Syria, Tunisia, Turkey, United Arab Emirates, and Yemen.

Candidates are required to attached to the application:

- Copy of Passport;
- Detailed Academic Curriculum Vitae:
- Full Academic Transcripts in English;
- Motivational Letter;
- One Reference Letter;
- Certification of knowledge of English (at least C1).

Final admission will be formulated by assessing for each candidate his/her academic degree, academic curriculum vitae (CV), motivation letter, level of knowledge of English and an interview.

Candidates will be ranked according to the following grading scale:

- Academic Resume: up to 15 points
- Motivation Letter: up to 15 points
- Reference Letter: up to 15 points
- Interview: up to 55 points

Only candidates receiving over **40 points** from the combined evaluation of their academic resume, motivation and reference letters will be invited for the motivation interview to be held remotely.

The final ranking of applications will be drawn up by the Management Committee of the Master. The Management Committee will verify the formal regularity of the documents and announce admission. The Management Committee bears the full responsibility of the selection procedure and its result. Winners will be informed using the email contact indicated in the application. A reserve list of candidates will also be prepared.

Within five days from the date of this communication, winners must send the Luiss School of Government their formal acceptance and any other requested documents. Failing to do so, the Management Committee will move to the first candidate of the reserve list.





School of Government Luiss School of Government will only fund the selected participant. Family members or travel companions will

not be funded and will not receive support for resident and travel visa to Italy.
